Hello Church Family!

If you would like to attend a Sunday morning service, **you will need to let us know you are coming.** Seating will be limited to 125 people on the main floor of the auditorium. The balcony is closed. If more than 125 attend, we will arrange for overflow seating where you can watch the service. The registration form will be in a weekly email and text and is available by clicking on a button on our website under ReLaunch.

If you choose not to attend in person, you are welcome to join us at home during our service times, as our 8:30am and 11:00am worship services will be streamed LIVE on our website.

MASKS

At this time, **masks are mandatory throughout** any worship service, event, class, or in-person meeting held on campus at PR. If you do not have a mask, or forget your mask, we will have a limited number of masks available at the entry on Sunday mornings.

PARKING

When you arrive at the church, please leave at least one parking space between your car and the cars around you. We still want to try to maintain some distance from one another as the CDC is recommending.

ENTRY

Entry will only be through the front doors near the circle; other entrances are closed. As you walk into the building, someone will greet you and help you find a place to sit. We will not have printed bulletins. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building. Please use the restrooms in Founder's Hall. MUGG is closed and the water fountains are off.

SEATING

The Worship Center will look a little different from usual for several reasons, but you should find a group of chairs to fit your family. Please refrain from hugging and shaking hands. A wave will let others know you are glad to be together.

THE SERVICE

Each worship service will last approximately 60 minutes and will include a time of singing, communion, announcements, and the sermon. No children's programming nor nurseries will be available. No Bible classes will meet.

COMMUNION/OFFERING

Communion will be provided in individually wrapped packs that you can pick up as you enter the auditorium. Please dispose of these in the trash can outside the Founder's Hall auditorium doors as you leave. We will not be passing communion trays.

We will not pass offering baskets, but instead you may place your contribution in the offering basket that will be located outside of the exit door. Giving envelopes will be available. If you are able to do so, we encourage you to give online. Just click on GIVING at the top of the homepage of the <u>PR website</u> and follow the simple instructions.

LEAVING

After the service is over, we ask that you leave the building in a timely fashion. We are scheduling our services at 8:30am and 11:00am so our cleaning crew will have time to fully sanitize the building in between the services.
