Discussion Questions (pick 1-2 to spend more time with):

2. This so-called ‘cleansing of the temple’ was also a premeditated and deliberate act on the part of Jesus. What were the issues that Jesus was protesting and how are they still relevant today?
3. How do you think the marginalized and outcast would have felt watching Jesus as he kicked out the money changers?
4. If you were a religious leader at the temple at this time, how would you have responded to Jesus’s actions?
5. Consider these 4 commands from Jesus from v. 20-27. Which one(s) do you see the most evidence of in your life? Which one(s) do you need to take a step of growth in? a. Have faith in God (v.22) b. Pray (v.23-24) c. Forgive others (v.25) d. Receive forgiveness from God (v.25).
